

A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Armando Silva called the July 18, 2022, Regular Board Meeting of the Fontainbleau Lakes Community Development District (the "District") to order at 6:31 p.m. in the Las Ramblas Clubhouse Conference Room located at 9960 NW 10th Terrace, Miami, Florida 33172.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Silva presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on June 28, 2022 and July 5, 2022, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Silva determined that the attendance of Vice-Chairman Timothy Toy and Supervisors Edward Aparicio, Humberto Jovanovic and Mayra De Torres (arrived at approximately 6:40 p.m.) constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Staff in attendance were: District Manager Armando Silva of Special District Services, Inc.; and General Counsel Scott Cochran and Gregory George of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A.

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

Mr. Edward Aparicio requested to have the following item added to the agenda for discussion:

- Potential Installation of a Gate Door from the Las Sevillas Southeasternmost Point to Ruben Dario Park
 - Mr. Aparicio requested that the District look into potentially installing a gate door on the southeasternmost point of Las Sevillas to provide access to residents that commute to/from the Ruben Dario Park.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES1. May 16, 2022, Regular Board Meeting

Mr. Silva presented the minutes of the May 16, 2022, Regular Board Meeting.

There being no changes or corrections, a **motion** was made by Mr. Toy, seconded by Mr. Aparicio and passed unanimously approving the minutes of the May 16, 2022, Regular Board Meeting, as presented.

<u>Note</u>: At approximately 6:57 p.m., Mr. Silva recessed the Regular Meeting and simultaneously opened the Public Hearing.

G. PUBLIC HEARING – ADOPTING A FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023 FINAL BUDGET 1. Proof of Publication

Mr. Silva presented proof of publication that notice of the Public Hearing had been published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on June 28, 2022 and July 5, 2022, as legally required.

2. Receive Public Comment on the Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Final Budget

Mr. Silva opened the public comment portion of the public hearing to receive comments on the 2022/2023 fiscal year final budget and non-ad valorem special assessments. There being no comments from the public on the 2022/2023 fiscal year budget and assessments, Mr. Silva closed the public comment portion of the Public Hearing.

3. Consider Resolution No. 2022-02 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Final Budget

Mr. Silva presented Resolution No. 2022-02, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE FONTAINBLEAU LAKES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING AND ADOPTING A FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023 FINAL BUDGET INCLUDING NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Silva read the title of the resolution into the record and stated that it provides for approving and adopting the fiscal year 2022/2023 final budget and non-ad valorem special assessment tax roll. Mr. Silva further stated that letters to property owners were mailed to all of the property owners stating that the overall assessments were increasing. For review purposes, a copy of the tax roll was provided at the meeting. A discussion ensued after which:

A **motion** was made by Mr. Toy, seconded by Ms. De Torres and unanimously passed to approve and adopt Resolution No. 2022-02, *as presented*, thereby setting the 2022/2023 final budget and non-ad valorem special assessment tax roll.

<u>Note</u>: At approximately 7:25 p.m., Mr. Silva closed the Public Hearing and simultaneously reconvened the Regular Meeting.

H. OLD BUSINESS

1. Update Regarding Restrictive Covenant – Greenspace Area in Southwest Quadrant of CDD

Mr. Silva stated that he has received the following response from Sandra Rezola of Miami-Dade County DERM:

Good afternoon Armando and Pablo,

Thank you for the clear figures provided. The orange netting areas (where source removal was conducted) should be backfilled with clean fill material from a Miami-Dade County quarry, and I will need documentation (receipts) of the clean fill material utilized. This will be addressed in a correspondence to be issued shortly.

With respect to the playgrounds, yes, they are permissible given the closure conditions in the pending restrictive covenants (i.e., "the site shall be maintained a park").

Mr. Cochran provided a brief explanation regarding the Restrictive Covenant and stated that this needs to be recorded in order to be in compliance with Miami-Dade County regarding the soil test sites. A discussion ensued after which;

A **motion** was made by Mr. Aparicio, seconded by Mr. Toy and unanimously passed approving the Declaration of Restrictive Covenant between the Fontainbleau Lakes CDD and Miami-Dade County.

H. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Resolution No. 2022-03 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Meeting Schedule

Mr. Silva presented Resolution No. 2022-03, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE FONTAINBLEAU LAKES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, ESTABLISHING A REGULAR MEETING SCHEDULE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023 AND SETTING THE TIME AND LOCATION OF SAID DISTRICT MEETINGS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Silva provided an explanation for the resolution. A discussion ensued after which;

A **motion** was made by Mr. Toy, seconded by Ms. De Torres and passed unanimously to approve and adopt Resolution No. 2022-03, *as presented*; and thereby setting the 2022/2023 Regular Meeting schedule and authorizes the publication of the schedule, as required by law.

2. Discussion Regarding Potential Addition of Overflow Parking

Mr. Silva stated that there has been an increase in illegally parked vehicles in the tract located near the intersection of NW 97th Court and NW 8th Street with the Las Ramblas community. A majority of the time, the illegally parked vehicles end up belonging to residents. Mr. Silva reminded the Board and those in attendance that the District established parking rules which prohibit vehicles from parking within any District owned right-of-ways. A solution to the overflow parking concern would be to create additional overflow parking within the tract near NW 97th Court and NW 8th Street. A discussion ensued after which the board directed Mr. Silva to create a survey that would be distributed to all of the residents of Las Ramblas asking if they are for/against the installation of an overflow parking lot near the aforementioned area.




K. ADJOURNMENT
















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LAS SEVILLAS & RUDEN DARIO PARK


























PROPOSED CONNECTION
